The decision of the Palestine Liberation Organization to seek full membership of the State of Palestine in the United Nations constitutes the beginning of an important phase in the national struggle to end the Israeli occupation and achieve independence.

Palestinians aspire to a future of freedom, dignity and prosperity, like all other peoples of the world. The right of the Palestinian people to self-determination and to establish its state on the 1967 borders with East Jerusalem as its capital is a natural, historical and legal right. It is also a right guaranteed by all international laws, including the United Nations Charter and Resolutions, at the forefront of which is United Nations General Assembly Resolution 181 (II).

As such, Palestine's membership at the United Nations is an important step towards freedom. Full membership will bring the Palestinians closer to ending the Israeli occupation and exercising their inalienable rights, including the right of self-determination and the return of refugees on the basis of United Nations resolution 194.

For this reason Women in Black (Vienna) and the Palestinian Community Austria is supporting the recognition of Palestine as the 194th Full Member State of the United Nations.
